The 2023 Junior Super Series will be comprised of Junior racing at the 2023 Cervelo Super Series events listed below, which will be referred to by their Super Series Round names in much of the promotional material surrounding the Series.

Entries

The 2023 Junior Super Series events listed below are open to riders who hold an AusCycling RACE Licence. A Series Pass can be purchased on Entryboss prior to the beginning of the Series for entry into all Rounds.

Please note: While the Senior Super Series grades will race a TTT and Road Race on October 1, The Junior Super Series will only race a Road Race

Technical Regulations

The 2023 Junior Super Series events will be conducted under the AusCycling rules and regulations. <u>Visit the AusCycling Rules & Policies page for more information.</u>

Second year J15 riders will be permitted to compete in J17 road events and graded Junior races from 1 October using J17 gearing, at the state/territory and club level. No exemption will be approved for an over distance race.

Second year J13 riders will be permitted to compete in J15 road events and graded Junior races from 1 October using J15 gearing, at the state/territory and club level. No exemption will be approved for an over distance race.

Red Light Policy

As all four rounds of the 2023 Junior Super Series will be held on closed-road criterium and kermesse circuits, no rear light is necessary.









Registration

Riders are required to register (sign-on) on the morning of each event.

Grading + Gender

The 2023 Junior Super Series will be run in four ability grades and separated by gender where there are suitable entry numbers based on Series Pass entries. It is expected that U17 riders enter A-grade, U15 riders enter B-Grade, U13 riders enter C-grade and U9 and U11 riders enter D-grade, however some riders may be suitable for a grade above or below that expected of them based on their age group. A beginner U15 may be better placed in C grade, and similarly a very experienced U15 may wish to race in A grade for the experience; all entries will be checked for suitability before being confirmed in any grade.

POINTS

The 2023 Junior Super Series shall be a points series. Points will be awarded based on final placings at each round as follows:

Race Numbers

Your race number is yours to keep safe for the duration of the 2023 Super Series. Even if you only entered in one round we will keep your number matched to your name for potential future rounds. Each rider MUST wear the correct number, no numbers are to be swapped between riders.





The leader of each grade's points classification will be provided with a custom number at each round which they are to wear during that round's racing.

You will be notified at Sign On for each round where numbers should be located on your jersey.

Presentations

All place getters must present to the podium immediately following the race finish. Presentations will be conducted by Series Organisers as quickly as is practicable after the race finish. Riders must be presented in their correct attire - race kit, no hats or sunglasses.

Littering

Riders must not discard bidons or rubbish of any kind on the roadside. Riders found to be littering will be fined in accordance AusCycling regulations.

Medical Services

First Aid support will be provided by Sports Trainer Services who will co-ordinate any further medical services required.

Road Closures + Round Info

Road closures will be in place for all Rounds of the 2023 Junior Super Series, more information about each Round can be found on the Super Series website. A Round Info document will be sent by email to all participants in the week leading up to each event.

Radio Communications

During races in the 2023 Junior Super Series, the use of radio links or any other means of communication with the riders is not permitted.

Prizes

No Prizemoney will be paid to any riders in the 2022 Junior Super Series. Prizing TBC

Acceptance of terms and conditions

It is a condition of entry into the Super Series that all riders accept the terms and conditions and the rules and regulations associated with this series. By nominating, these are deemed to have been accepted.

Notwithstanding the Special Rules of this series, Series organisers have the right to make amendments in good faith that are in the best interests of promoting the sport, the series, our sponsors and riders.
